- Develop and implement a whole school approach to differentiated teaching and learning including case management processes.
- Continue to refine the Whole School Curriculum Plan.
- Research program resources to support all students to have the tools of self-regulation and further develop in all aspects of the "You Can Do It!" program.
- Fund Initial Lit professional development for teachers.
